Guide to the Center

Community Life Support Center ASAYAKE would like to be 'the place' to provide the following:

Community Life Support Center provides 'support for daily living,' 'consultation,' and 'community exchange activities' for people with mental disabilities living in the community. This is a place for one to chat, have tea, easily ask for consultation when in trouble - in order to enrich the social life and enjoy living in the community.

Activities at the Community Life Support Center ASAYAKE

1. Consultation

We respond to consultations by telephone and in person. Feel free to consult with us on any issue, such as what you are concerned about in your daily life, something you might not understand about the welfare, medical or other systems, or troubles with family members.

If the content of consultation is technical, we will work together with public health centers, municipal office, center for mental health and welfare, hospitals, etc., so that we can help you resolve the issue.

If you wish to visit the Center and consult with us in person, kindly contact us in advance.

(Note: Kodaira City entrusts portions of their consultation services to the Center.)

2. Community exchange activities

1) Space for activities

- You can relax and enjoy yourself by having tea or chatting with others.
- Programs (please check our monthly schedule)
For example: Dinner gathering, Easy Cooking seminar, users' meeting *Kaze no Kai* (group of winds), Outing program, etc.

- Workshop to learn necessary skills of daily life or about welfare systems (at any time).
- 2) Community networks
 - We build networks with related institutions and volunteers.

3. Support for daily living

- Supervision of money management and medicine intake can be conducted upon consultation.
- We visit you or accompany you when necessary in collaboration with related institutions.
- A washing machine is available for your use (currently, the use of drying machines is under consideration).
- A bath room is available for your use (every Tuesday only, located on the second floor of the ASAYAKE No. 2 workshop).

Operating Hours:

Monday – Saturday (Closed on Sundays)

For national holidays, we are open only when the holiday is on a Monday or on a Saturday.

- Other closed days such as the end of year/New Year holidays will be informed in our magazine, 'Kaze (wind).'
- If your telephone consultation is made during our meetings, our answering machine will respond.

How do I register as a user?

If you use the Community Life Support Center ASAYAKE several times, and wish to continue your use, we would, in principle, request you to register.

What is the procedure of registration?

We will conduct an interview and request you to fill out a registration form.

- Registration fee 1200 yen per year
(The fee will be used for the cost of electricity/water and for the comprehensive compensation program).
- We request you to comply with the rules for "the Use of the Center" given in a separate document.
