THE PHILIPPINES stands at the crossroads of the developed western world and the Orient. It lies in the heart of Southeast Asia, stretching more than 1,840 kilometers. Composed of 7,107 islands, the Philippines is readily accessible to the different capitals of the world.
- The South China Sea washes its western shores. Taiwan, China and Hong Kong are northern neighbors and further north is Japan. To the west lie Southeast Asian countries such as Singapore, Malaysia and Thailand. An arm of the archipelago reaches out towards Borneo and at its feet stands the chain of Indonesian islands. To the east and south, the waters of the Pacific Ocean sweep its headlands, looking out towards Micronesia and Polynesia.
- Its unique location has made the Philippines the commercial, cultural and intellectual heart of Asia from the first light of history.

DEFINITION CLASSIFICATION OF DISABILITIES

- Physical or mental impairment

RA 7277 Magna Carta for disabled persons/ RA 9442

-An act providing for the rehabilitation, self-development and self-reliance of disabled persons, and additional priveleges and thier integration into the mainstream of the society and for other purposes.

BP 344 (Accessibility Law)

-An act to enhance the mobility of disabled persons by requiring certain buildings, institutions, establishments and public utilities to install facilities and other devices
